Re: Fare Flexibility and Digital Experience Initiative – Executive Succession

We write in regard to Order 16-02, dated September 21, 2016, by which the Commission approved the supplemental application for a major capital expenditure by British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (BC Ferries) for the Fare Flexibility and Digital Experience Initiative (FFDEI), subject to certain conditions.

In particular, condition 2 of Order 16-02 requires BC Ferries to:

[C]onfirm to the commissioners within 12 months of this Order that a senior executive sponsorship succession plan is in place.

BC Ferries confirms that as required by the Order, BC Ferries put in place and executed an executive sponsorship succession plan for FFDEI. The sponsorship role for oversight of the initiative has been assumed by Mr. Mark Collins, President & CEO.
